### BACKPACK CAMPING INFORMATION

Newport State Park has only 16 wilderness backpack sites in addition to one Group Site and one Bike Site, allowing for a unique and rewarding experience. Help us care for this resource to allow this experience to others who come camping in the future. Here are some important things to remember for your camping in the wilderness of Newport:

1. Campers must register and pay required fees before setting up camp. If park staff is not available, self-register at the park office. All campers must park in designated parking lots within the park and vehicles must have a valid Wisconsin State Park vehicle admission sticker.
2. Allow ample time to reach the site before dark.
3. Tents must be set up in designated areas, not on the shoreline. One family or not more than 6 persons may occupy a campsite. Pit toilets are located near each campsite.
4. Camp stoves are preferred. All other fires must be kept within the provided fire ring and the fire ring is NOT to be moved. Only dead and downed wood may be used for a fire. When leaving your site, be sure the fire is completely out.
5. Drinking water should be carried into the site. All leftover food, garbage, and recyclables must be carried out. Containers for garbage and recyclables will be found at the service building parking lot.
6. Porcupines and raccoons can sometimes be a problem. Take adequate precautions to protect your belongings. There is a steel storage box on each site for your use.
